Nature of work:	<p>The selected candidate will be required to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Support early-morning project activities involving pregnant women in community and institutional settings• Cleaning and preparation of assessment and data collection areas• Assist with logistical arrangements during biological sample collection• Safely transfer collected biological samples from the place of collection (participant homes or NCWB) to the designated laboratory, following project protocols• Ensure safe and hygienic handling of project materials and equipment• Facilitate smooth coordination during participant visits <p>Carry out any other project-related support work as assigned by the research team</p>
