<b>Essential Qualification:</b>	PUC
<b>Essential Experience:</b>	At least 1 year of experience in supporting research or hospital-based activities, including cleaning, logistical assistance, or field support.
<b>Languages :</b>	Proficiency in Kannada, including the ability to read, write, and communicate effectively. Basic knowledge of spoken English will be an added advantage.
<b>Nature of work:</b>	<p>The selected candidate will be required to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Support early-morning project activities involving pregnant women in community and institutional settings</li><li>Cleaning and preparation of assessment and data collection areas</li><li>Assist with logistical arrangements during biological sample collection</li><li>Safely transfer collected biological samples from the place of collection (participant homes or NCWB) to the designated laboratory, following project protocols</li><li>Ensure safe and hygienic handling of project materials and equipment</li><li>Facilitate smooth coordination during participant visits</li></ul> <p>Carry out any other project-related support work as assigned by the research team</p>
<b>Working Hours :</b>	8 hours per day (7:00 am to 3:00 pm) with flexibility for extended hours and occasional weekend duties as per project requirements.
<b>Work Location :</b>	NIMHANS Centre for Well-Being (located in BTM Layout, Bengaluru)
<b>Eligibility :</b>	As the project involves close interaction with pregnant women in community and home-based settings, only female candidates are eligible to apply. This requirement is essential to ensure participant comfort, privacy, cultural appropriateness, and ethical conduct of research activities.
