Essential Qualification:	Graduate degree in Public Health/Psychology/Social Work
Desirable Experience:	1. Experience in the area of mental health 2. Experience of working in projects/programs at State level. 3. Ability to fluently read, write and speak in Kannada and two of Hindi or Telugu or Tamil 4. Undertaken mental health related field-based data collection.
Emoluments:	Rs 28,000/- + 30% HRA P.M
Nature of work:	Candidate should be willing to travel to the study site, carry out data collection and liaison with local coordinators.
Maximum Age Limit:	35 years
Duration of Post:	Initial appointment will be for 6 months and may be extended further depending upon the performance of the candidate.
Specific responsibilities:	1. Carry out data collection at study site - Kolar 2. Carry out qualitative interviews if required. 3. Facilitate standard care to the participants in the control group. 4. Supervise the project junior nurse at the data collection site, liaison with the local health care providers, program managers, health officials. 5. Identify the households, explain the nature and study procedures to the parental dyad, take written informed consent, interview the participants with the semi-structured proforma and various study tools. 6. Assist in data verification, data checking, help in preparing data for statistical analysis, and preparation of study reports.

Desirous candidates who fulfil the eligibility criteria mentioned above are advised to appear for the Walk-in-cum-Written Test with their **resume** and **original** testimonials, along with a set of self-attested **photocopies**.

Venue: conducting the interview at Public Health Observatory, District Health Office, Kolar, as the study site of the project is in Kolar.

- Candidates are required to register their names **30 minutes** before the commencement of the written test/interview.
- No **TA/DA** will be paid for attending the written test/interview.
- Candidates currently working in projects (Extramural/Intramural) at NIMHANS must produce a No Objection Certificate (**NOC**) from their Principal Investigator.
- The candidate should have scored a **minimum of 50%** in the written examination (Whenever written examination is indicated) to qualify for the skill test/interview. For Direct Interview the candidate should score at least 50% Marks in the interview.
- The Institute reserves the right to select a suitable candidate. Possession of the prescribed essential qualifications alone does not guarantee selection.
